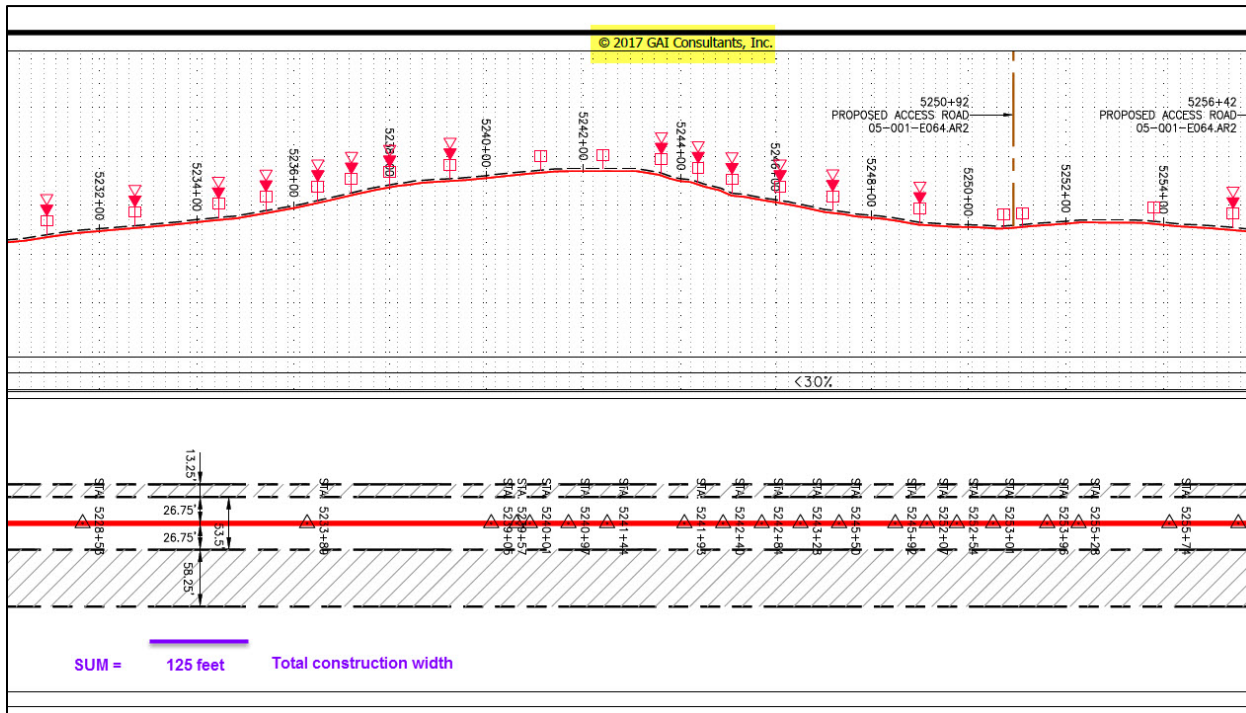


# YES, THERE WILL BE 125-FOOT RIDGELINE CONSTRUCTION CORRIDORS

The schematic below is excerpted from Atlantic Coast Pipeline construction alignment sheets submitted to the W.Va. DEP. The construction corridor is depicted as 125-foot wide or wider on the alignment sheets. This excerpt shows part of a 2-mile section adjacent the W.Va.-Va. border. A report by [RESPEC](#) indicates that 130,000 cubic yards of excess spoil material will be created in this area due to expansion of excavated material ([Atlantic Coast Pipeline and Supply Header Project Volumetric Analysis](#)).



The RESPEC analysis focused on the ACP construction corridor between Mile Posts 82 and 84. The critical-zone map below was prepared by the Dominion Pipeline Monitoring Coalition.
