Dear Ms. Adams:

I request all public records as listed below for the Atlantic Coast Pipeline (ACP). This request applies to the period of April 12, 2017 through today. With respect to site-specific information, this request is limited to five Virginia counties: Highland, Bath, Augusta, Nelson, and Buckingham.

- 1) Erosion and Sediment Control Plans, including narrative descriptions and schematic depictions or alignment sheets, for the pipeline corridor and other pipeline-related construction activities, including access roads, other workspace and staging areas.
- 2) Stormwater Management Plans, including narrative descriptions, schematic depictions or alignment sheets and computational spreadsheets, for the pipeline corridor and other pipeline-related construction activities, including access roads, other workspace and staging areas.
- 3) Descriptive material related to ACP's "Best In Class" program and other slope-stabilization plans, including narrative descriptions and site-specific designs, depictions and alignment sheets.
- 4) Any correspondence related to the above (items 1-3) between DEQ and the ACP developers or their contractors and consultants.
