Dear Ms. Adams:

In accordance with the Virginia Freedom of Information Act, Code of Virginia § 2.2-3700 et. seq., I request that you provide any “public records” meeting the descriptions below. Records supplied should include but not be limited to all correspondence and notes from meetings or telephone conversations in all media.

- Any data or other information collected or reviewed by DEQ with the purpose and intent to assess whether activities that have previously been covered by and were in compliance with U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Nationwide Permit number 12 (NWP 12) and Regional conditions associated with NWP 12 can meet or have met Virginia water quality standards. These records should cover the period between February 15, 2017 and the date of this letter.
- Any analysis or discussion of data or information as described above.

In relation to all information requested herein, we ask that DEQ waive any fees for their production, because these records are sought to inform the public and serve general public interests. Further, we ask that DEQ not exclude any record or part thereof under exemptions provided in the Virginia Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) unless a provision of state law specifically prohibits disclosure.

If no records meeting the descriptions above are in DEQ’s custody, please notify me of that fact.
